Rules:

1. Matches will consist of two games to 21, must win by 2 (cap at 25). All games will have a 30-minute time limit. If a game is tied when the time limit is up, you will need to play one more point.
2. Each team will get a 10-minute warm up for their first game and a 2-minute warm up for each game after that. The timer will be set for 5 minutes and will be started right after the game is over. The first 3 minutes will be reserved for a captains meeting and the other 2 minutes for serving.
3. Games will start early when possible.
4. The top team in each pool will advance to Championship Round. There is no time limit. They will play the best of three to 25. If game three is needed, it is still to 15. They do not need to win by two in third game.
5. Locker rooms will be assigned.
6. One time-out per game. The clock does not stop. There are no time-outs in last 2 minutes of the 30-minute time limit.
7. Every team is responsible to bring one adult line judge for each match and one person for the scorebook. The team listed first is the home team and they will do the book.
8. Please mail the \$75 entry fee per team before the tournament starts. Checks can be made payment to ORCS Athletics.
9. Concessions will be sold throughout the day.
10. Admission: Adults \$6.00, Students \$4.00
11. Bus Drivers - please park across the street in the North parking lot.
